Randolph Lane Park next to Pilmuir Primary School is a great space for families to come together to play and socialise – this is especially important as many families meet **on the way to school**.

Working to the Council's brief we aim to **doubling** the space for play, greatly increasing the play value and range of equipment. There will be play options for every child on site with **accessible items**, interactive equipment but also **large dynamic items** for older ages.

The "Warrior" and "Stay to Play" tower units give two main age range options for children to play with friends and families. Our communication panel and nature activity station bring more inclusive values to the play park.

- The activity station allows for **investigation and exploration** of what the features the children can play with, whether it be together or by themselves.
- Our newly designed Communication panel, based on the NHS system, opens up play for those who are **nonverbal** by giving a communicate option about how they wish to play on the site.

Children coming to play will have the choice of being able to **zoom** down the **exhilarating** zip slide, spin with friends on the inclusive roundabout, fly high in the basket swing all while being safety fenced away from the commuter cycle lane.

The climbing wall and agility trail items will push children to the test giving them an outlet to tie into their "health and wellbeing" attribute of the curriculum for excellence from school.
